


# Arrival at Fin Lit Island

In turn, you will move around the Superyacht, using the cursor on your screen, finding fiendishly hidden clues, and solving puzzles and riddles. Every time you solve a puzzle and provide an answer, you can move to the next question, but not before.

#### Your biggest enemy:

**TIME** - you have 45 minutes to complete the 10 questions to complete your escape.



## Getting started

- 1. Sign in to get your Travel ticket.
- 2. Choose your Avatar from the collection you can see on the flight Deck.
- 3. Controlling the cursor, move round the control deck and find the captain.
- 4. Read the question, answer it on screen. If it's correct you will be given a clue to go and find the next question, hidden somewhere on the **Superyacht M Power**.



## Winning

By question nine you will have arrived at the idyllic Fin Lit Island

Answer the final question and you will join the happy team who have successfully navigated their way to a heightened state of Financial Literacy.

And you will receive a spectacular Certificate of Achievement.

### Losers

What if you don't make it to the idyllic Fin Lit Island?

That might be because you don't get the puzzles or the team doesn't function well.

No matter, you can try again.

But remember, it won't be the same questions. Similar but not the same.



## Playing Solo

You always are the person to find the clues and work out the puzzles; use whatever means you like to get to the right answer – except when it take you too long so you can't complete it in the time available.

## Playing in Teams

Each player should take it in turns to find the clue – you should work collaboratively in a real or virtual environment to come to the right conclusion – in some versions of the game you will have to work solo for some of the questions and collaboratively, as a team with others.



## Still puzzled?

Here are some sample questions you won't find in the game.

#### **Sample Numeracy question 1**

Before embarking on our **Superyacht M Power**, the last group were excited to be working together. At the end of the briefing they shook hands with each other - there were 66 handshakes - how many people were in the group?

### Sample: Coping with Inflation

Inflation is the gradual loss of purchasing power, reflected in a broad rise in prices for goods and services. For example, in 1970, the average cup of coffee cost 25 cents; by 2019, it had climbed to \$1.59.

For \$5, how many cups of coffee would you have been able to buy in 2019, as opposed to 1970?



#### Saving v Borrowing when inflation is High

Your joint monthly salary with your partner (after deductions) is £3000.00.

Your goal is to get married in two years.

#### **Question A**

The average cost of an engagement ring in the UK is

**A:** £781 | **B:** £1011 | **C:** £1471

#### **Question B**

In two years' time, assuming the price of the ring rises in line with inflation at 13.5%, what price will the same ring be £1895?
